



STOCKPORT GRAMMAR SCHOOL SENIOR SCHOOL **BOYS' UNIFORM**

All pupils must wear the School uniform in accordance with the published list. All items must be clearly marked with the pupil's forename and surname.

FIRST TO FIFTH FORMS

A neat appearance is expected at all times. Hair can be dyed but it must not be bright or extreme colours. Pupils should be clean shaven; if pupils wear a beard for faith reasons, facial hair must be neat. Pupils are allowed to wear official school badges and watches (but not smart watches). Pupils may wear one stud in one or both earlobes. No other forms of jewellery, badges or other piercings are permitted. Jewellery must be removed for PE/Games and other practical activities as requested by staff. Pupils may wear discreet and not noticeable make-up. Nail varnish and acrylic nails are not permitted.

Essential Items:

- a) *School Blazer
- b) ^ School Tie
- c) Trousers (full-length and conventional in style: straight leg, not bootleg, skinny, tapered or tight fitting, and not jeans, corduroy or chinos)
- d) Shirt (plain white)
- e) Socks (plain black or dark grey)
- f) Shoes (black orthodox leather style, suitable for school wear - no boots, pump-style or trainer-style shoes)
- g) PE Kit -
 - ** School PE Shirt (black/gold polo and/or black/gold tee shirt)
 - ** Shorts (black with school crest)
 - ** Reversible Games Shirt (black/gold reversible)
 - ** Socks (black and gold stripes) for Games
 - Socks (white) for PE Lessons
 - ** Fleece top
 - ** Training Trousers
 - Water bottle
 - Trainers
 - Football or Rugby Boots (do not need to be black)
 - Shin pads for football
 - Swimming trunks or shorts (plain black), flip flops, swim hat and towel – First Year only

We strongly recommend that all boys wear a gum shield for Rugby and Hockey

Optional Items:

- a) Coat (plain dark colour)
- b) *School Pullover or Sleeveless Top (plain black, V-neck with school crest)
- c) *School Scarf (or plain black)

SENIOR SCHOOL - SIXTH FORM

A neat appearance is expected at all times. Hair can be dyed but it must not be bright or extreme colours. Facial hair must be neat. Pupils are allowed to wear official school badges and watches (but not smart watches). Pupils may wear multiple earrings of their choice but these must be of practical length; they may also wear a nose stud but not nose ring. No other forms of jewellery, badges or other piercings are permitted. Jewellery must be removed for PE/Games and other practical activities as requested by staff. Pupils may wear discreet and not noticeable make-up. Nail polish can be worn but it must not be bright or extreme colours. Acrylic nails are allowed but they must be of practical length.

Uniform items as for First to Fifth Forms, except for the following:

- a) *Blazer (black without yellow braid but with badge)
- b) Pullover or Sleeveless Top (plain black, V-neck, with or without school crest)
- c) It is not compulsory for pupils to wear school PE kit for timetabled Games/PE lessons

FIRST TO FIFTH FORMS

A neat appearance is expected at all times. Hair can be dyed but it must not be bright or extreme colours. Pupils are allowed to wear official school badges and watches (but not smart watches). Pupils may wear one stud in one or both earlobes. No other forms of jewellery, badges or other piercings are permitted. Jewellery must be removed for PE/Games and other practical activities as requested by staff. Pupils may wear discreet and not noticeable make-up. Nail varnish and acrylic nails are not permitted.

- c) *Skirt (plain black with school crest, kick pleat, knee length) OR plain black trousers (full-length and conventional in style: straight leg, not bootleg, skinny, tapered or tight fitting, and not jeans, corduroy or chinos)
- d) Blouse (plain white)
- e) Tights (plain black) or socks (plain black, not trainer-liners unless worn with tights)
- f) Shoes (black orthodox leather style, suitable for school wear - no boots, pump-style or trainer-style shoes), (heels no higher than 5cm and no platform soles)
- g) PE Kit –
 - ** School PE Shirt (black/gold polo and/or black/gold tee shirt)
 - ** Skort
 - ** Games Shirt
- s)
 - ** Shorts (black with school crest) - optional
 - ** Socks (black and gold stripes) for Games
 - Socks (white) for PE Lessons
 - ** Fleece top
 - ** Leggings or Training Trousers or both
 - Water bottle
 - Trainers
 - Shin pads for football/hockey
 - Swimming costume (plain black), flip flops, swim hat and towel – First Year only

Optional Items:

- b) *School Pullover (plain black, V-neck with school crest)

- d) Hijab (plain black)
