





STOCKPORT GRAMMAR SCHOOL SENIOR SCHOOL **BOYS' UNIFORM**

All pupils must wear the School uniform in accordance with the published list. All items must be clearly marked with the pupil's forename and surname.







FIRST TO FIFTH FORMS

A neat appearance is expected at all times. Hair can be dyed but it must not be bright or extreme colours. Pupils should be clean shaven; if pupils wear a beard for faith reasons, facial hair must be neat. Pupils are allowed to wear official school badges and watches (but not smart watches). Pupils may wear one stud in one or both earlobes. No other forms of jewellery, badges or other piercings are permitted. Jewellery must be removed for PE/Games and other practical activities as requested by staff. Pupils may wear discreet and not noticeable make-up. Nail varnish and acrylic nails are not permitted.

Essential School Items:


- a) School Blazer 
- b) School Tie 
- c) Trousers (full-length and conventional in style: straight leg, not bootleg, skinny, tapered or tight fitting, and not jeans, corduroy or chinos)
- d) Shirt (plain white)
- e) Socks (plain black or dark grey)
- f) Shoes (black orthodox leather style, suitable for school wear - no boots, pump-style or trainer-style shoes)

Essential Games and PE Kit Items:


- a) PE Polo Top (black/gold) and/or PE Tee-Shirt (black/gold) 
- b) Shorts (black with school crest) 
- c) Games Top (black/gold reversible) 
- d) Games Socks (black and gold stripes) 
- e) Outer layer - one or more of the following: Fleece / Sweatshirt / Winter Jacket / Waterproof 
- f) Tracksuit Bottoms 
- g) Socks (white) for PE Lessons

All items listed above are compulsory for PE lessons, Games lessons, training & fixtures. We hope that playing sporting fixtures for school becomes a central part of your child's time at SGS. For away games, pupils are expected to wear their chosen Stockport Grammar School outer layer and tracksuit bottoms (as detailed above) as their travelling kit. This doubles up as their outer wear for lessons, particularly in winter months.

Other Essential Items

- a) Water bottle
- b) Trainers
- c) Football or rugby boots (do not need to be black)
- d) Shin pads for football and hockey
- e) Swimming trunks or shorts (plain black), flip flops, swim hat  and towel – First Year only
- f) Gumshield- We strongly recommend that all boys and girls wear a gum shield for Rugby and Hockey.

- a) Coat (plain dark colour)
- b) School Pullover or Sleeveless Top (plain black, V-neck with school crest) 
- c) School Scarf  (or plain black)
- d) House PE Top 

SENIOR SCHOOL - SIXTH FORM

A neat appearance is expected at all times. Hair can be dyed but it must not be bright or extreme colours. Facial hair must be neat. Pupils are allowed to wear official school badges and watches (but not smart watches). Pupils may wear multiple earrings of their choice but these must be of practical length; they may also wear a nose stud but not nose ring. No other forms of jewellery, badges or other piercings are permitted. Jewellery must be removed for PE/Games and other practical activities as requested by staff. Pupils may wear discreet and not noticeable make-up. Nail polish can be worn but it must not be bright or extreme colours. Acrylic nails are allowed but they must be of practical length.

Uniform items as for First to Fifth Forms, except for the following:

- a) Blazer (black without yellow braid but with badge) 
- b) Pullover or Sleeveless Top (plain black, V-neck, with or without school crest)
- c) It is not compulsory for pupils to wear school PE kit for timetabled Games/PE lessons

FIRST TO FIFTH FORMS

- e) Tights (plain black) or socks (plain black, not trainer-liners unless worn with tights)
- f) Shoes (black orthodox leather style, suitable for school wear - no boots, pump-style or trainer-style shoes), (heels no higher than 5cm and no platform soles)

Essential Games and PE Kit Items:




- a) PE Polo Top (black/gold polo) and/or PE Tee-Shirt (black/gold) 
- b) Shorts (black with school crest) and/or Skort 
- c) Games Top (black with gold piping) 
- d) Games Socks (black and gold stripes) 
- e) Outer layer – one or more of the following: Fleece / Sweatshirt / Winter Jacket / Waterproof 
- f) Tracksuit Bottoms and/or Leggings 
- g) Socks (white) for PE Lessons

All items listed above are compulsory for PE lessons, Games lessons, training & fixtures. We hope that playing sporting fixtures for school becomes a central part of your child's time at SGS. - d) It is not compulsory for pupils to wear school PE kit for timetabled Games/PE lessons
